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THE ISLAND

Koh Samui, or "Samui" for vernacular speakers, is located in the Gulf of Thailand. It is the second largest island in Thailand after Phuket and measures 25 kilometres at the widest point. The main road runs along the beautiful coastline and is approximately 51 kilometres long. In contrast to the stunning beaches, the central part of the island consists of a tropical, jungle mountain.

The island was inhabited centuries ago by fishermen from China. Today the island is a melting pot of people coming here from all four corners of the world. The island appeals just as much to the mega-rich as the backpackers travelling on a budget.

The largest and most popular area is located on the east side of the island and is called Chaweng. Chaweng, the current hub of Koh Samui, is located near the airport and offers beautiful golden sand stretches, bars, restaurants and shops. Nathos is located on the west side of the island and is the old capital of Koh Samui. This is still the main port, business district and the centre of the fishing industry. Two of the other major tourist resorts are Lamai Beach and Bophut Beach.

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DO & SEE

Wat Plai Laem

Wat Plai Laem is one of Koh Samui's most attractive temples. This fairly new sight was completed in 2004 and is a colourful complex with a traditional Thai-Chinese style. The temple holds two giant, colourful statues (Happy Buddha and the eighteen armed Kuan Yin) that will catch your eye. Do not miss the large Golden Buddha inside Wat Plai Laem.

Koh Tao

Koh Tao means "Turtle Island" in Thai and was once an important breeding ground for sea turtles. Since 2004 hundreds of juvenile turtles have been reintroduced to the island's ecosystem thanks to a co-operation between the Royal Navy and local Dive Operators. The island is worldwide famous for its beautiful coral reef and marine life which makes it a perfect place for snorkelling.

Koh Nangyuan

hundred meters from Ko Tao. This amazing island is linked to two other islands by an incredible limb of white sand. This is claimed to be one of the best places for snorkelling in the archipelago of Samui. Koh Nangyuan is truly a spectacular place where you can unwind without disturbing cars and hustle.

Secret Buddha Garden

The Secret Buddha Garden was built in 1976 by a fruit farmer called Nim Thongsuk and it took around fifteen years to finish the garden. This peaceful place can be found in the hills of Samui Island in the verdant jungle. The garden is decorated with sculptures portraying both humans and deities in various poses. Getting to the garden is quite difficult so booking a tour in advance is highly recommended.

Wat Khunaram (Mummified Monk)

Koh Samui's mummified monk at Wat Khunaram is an unusual sight, but still offers a unique insight into Buddhist and Thai culture. The mummified monk Luong Pordaeng died in 1973 and ever since his body has been on display in a glass case at the temple. Remarkably, the monk's

body shows little sign of decay.

This beautiful landscaped garden features many colourful tropical flowers and hundreds of spectacular butterflies.

The place looks like a big open-air garden but it is actually covered with a net, allowing the butterflies to fly freely. For those who like bugs, there is also an insect museum as well as a bee house onsite.

Big Buddha Temple (Wat Phra Yai)

Big Buddha Temple, locally known as Wat Phra Yai, is majestically located on a small rocky island off Koh Samui's north-eastern corner (Koh Faan). This golden, twelve-meter seated Buddha statue was built in 1972 and is one of the island's most popular tourist attractions.

Since this is a sacred place, one should dress appropriately (cover the shoulders and wear trousers or long shorts).

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Airport

Samui Airport is considered to be one of the most beautiful airports in the world after its thorough makeover. Between Departures and Arrivals you can find a large shopping centre.

Leaving or arriving Koh Samui, you can choose between private and shared airport transfer. In the arrivals hall you will find a transportation counter where you can book both transfer and private taxi. A trip with a private taxi to

Chaweng will cost you about 500Bath and a private minivan about 800Bath. A shared minivan with a minimum of 5 passengers will cost about 130Bath per person. The prices vary depending on your final destination.

Public Transport

On Koh Samui you will get by easily with "Songthaews", motor bike taxis and taxis. The Songthaews are the main means of transportation on the island and you should expect to pay approximately 30-50Bath. They operate from early morning regularly during the day.
