In 1857, the city of Orlando officially adopted its name. Though there are many stories about how the name Orlando was chosen, one of the most prominent explanations is that then-judge James Speer named it after a character from Shakespeare's "As You Like It."

Major events in Orlando history include 1965, when Walt Disney announced his plans to build Walt Disney World—one reason why the masses still flock to Orlando today. The other major event happened when the original airport was built in 1962.

Metro Orlando has a rapidly growing \$13.4 billion technology industry that employs 53,000 people. It is recognized nationally for the industries of digital media, aviation, software and aerospace. More than 150 international companies have facilities in Orlando.

Orlando's climate is humid and subtropical with two major seasons a year. From June to September, the weather is hot and rainy, while the dry season lasts from October through May.




